The thesis statement is probably the most important sentence in your paper!

It is a **concise sentence** that summarizes the **central point** of your essay or paper. It typically appears near the end of the introduction. Its purpose is to guide the reader by clearly stating the main idea that the paper will explore or argue.

Remember to:

- · keep it concise
- **make it contentious**: don't state a fact everyone knows, make a claim that makes further evidence and analysis necessary.
- **make it coherent**: everything mentioned in the thesis statement should be supported and explained in the main body.
